Thank God for leading us to several new experiences in seven major events in China and Malaysia in this quarter. We were greatly encouraged by the experiences and would like to highlight them as our thanksgiving to our Lord as well as for your prayer support.

- i. We were saved from having troubles with the government authority in China when the police came to investigate the Marriage Enrichment camps held in Ning-An (Hangzhou) and Handan (Hebei) after we verified that we were working under a registered company. This showed that the registration of our company in Hangzhou this year was in His right time.
- ii. It was a Good strategy to assign our newly trained family life educators to launch the ministry by organizing marriage enrichment camps in their respective churches, so that our work would be able to spread speedily through the trainees who came from various regions in China.

- iii. Pastors' involvement: Most of the pastors who came from Wenzhou were convinced that their Sunday school ministry should work hand in hand with our family life ministry. They realized that the wellbeing of the parents' marriage is the main factor that affects the spiritual development of the children after they attended the camp in Pingtan (Fuzhou). One of them has even engaged us to conduct a Family Life Educators Training session in his district at the beginning of next year.
- iv. The joint venture with the mission team of Barker Road Methodist Church for the project in Guilin had taught us that we should train interested mission groups of our local churches to lead workshops in the marriage enrichment camps. This

may expose them to our approach of converting unbelieving spouses through the camps in China.

- v. In Malaysia: Our Family Life Education seminar and a church camp that we had conducted in two Chinese Methodist Churches in Kuala Lumpur had moved a bilingual pastor to offer to translate our books into English. He felt that our approach to family life education is relevant and applicable to today's English speaking churches as well.
